THE LADIES SOCIETY HISTORY

Always in the history of the church, devoted Christian women have made contributions of inestimable value to the cause of the Kingdom of God. They have willingly given of time, talent and material resources. Their interest and consecration have been a strong sustaining influence in the life of many congregations. This is true also at Zion. Since 1870, under the pastorate of Rev. Zeller, the ladies society has been the right hand of the congregation and has laid many an offering on the altar for the advancement of the Master's work.

The early minutes are not available and the exact time of its organization is not known. It is certain, however, that the Ladies Guild has existed and been active for a period of over 150 years. Prior to that there were certain charitable activities that had been promoted by women of the congregation but they did not seem to have been formally organized.
